There is a lot more to an emcee's responsibility than just announcing arrivals and/or agendas. Every attendees' experience is mainly affected by the emcee's presence.

- 1. S/he is a spokesperson representing the hosts (families/organization).
- 2. S/he dresses up properly & appropriately.
- 3. S/he behave in good mannerisms (bodily movements, hand gestures & overall posture).
- 4. S/he always make sure the flow of the event itinerary is followed accordingly. Time-keeper.
- 5. S/he keeps the audience well informed by smoothening the continuity of the agendas.
- 6. S/he is able to build up the audience's mood by fetching applauses to prevent awkward silence or 'cold' atmosphere.
- 7. S/he must be clear & articulate in his/her announcements.
- 8. S/he is to be responsive and alert at all times to take over a situation in a calm and assured manner in case when there's any technical issues or emergencies. S/he reacts wisely.

Now, what are the basics to an emcee's job?

- Inviting and introducing speaker(s) before their speeches, announcing the food presentation & video/slide presentations, are the usual emcee's fundamentals.
- 10. S/he presents the arrival/march-ins of the VIPs, bride & groom, i.e. the main focus of an event with proper their designations, with grace and intonation.
- 11. S/he welcomes the guests during the event opening with some interesting relatable information besides being interactive.
- 12. General announcements such as parking ticket validations, food stations, are all to be done in an improvised manner by the emcee.

And what makes an emcee special?

- 13. Hosting the wedding cake-cutting, champagne pouring, and the family 'yam-seng' toasting session with sweet traditional phrases are the specialties of a wedding emcee.
- 14. Conducting games and interviews with early preparations are some of the extra responsibilities of an emcee; how well the homework is done is shown on stage.
- 15. Thanking the guests for their presence with a heart-warming closing note (during the last song) separates a classy emcee from the ordinary.
- 16. If s/he is witty and charming when answering questions, that a bonus!
